**& 1's:**

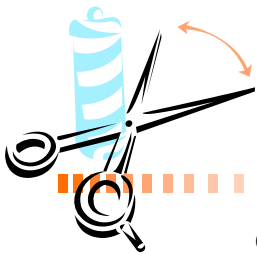
