COVID - 19 UPDATE & GUIDELINES

- All people entering the building besides staff and children should be wearing a mask.
- Upon arrival you can now enter through the main sliding doors. We will no longer be taking children's temperatures as they arrive.
- For your use, hand sanitizers are located in every classroom and in the lobby.
- We do ask that you keep an eye out for any symptoms while your child is at home.

Updated Covid- 19 illness policies:

- If your child has a fever of 100 or higher, or any other major Covid symptom, they will have to be out of school for 72 hours. If the fever is persistent, they will need a negative Covid test and a doctor's note to return to school
- Any siblings will also need to be kept home. This will cut down on possible cross contamination.
- We will be asking for doctor's notes more this cold/flu/Covid season so make sure that children are being seen and taking all of the possible precautions to prevent the spread of Covid in the center.
- If a parent or anyone in direct contact with the child has tested positive your child will need to stay out of childcare for 14 days, or longer depending on possible symptoms.

Please keep in mind that there are many unknowns in the world with Covid right now and we are tracking updated guidelines continuously. At any time, any of these guidelines could change depending on local government and state regulations. Please be mindful that we have no control over Covid, and our #1 concern is keeping all of our staff and your children as safe as we possibly can.

If and when we do have a positive case of Covid, parents will be notified immediately. We will try our best to isolate the affected group and avoid a center closure.
