### Updated health policy:

We've made some slight changes to our Covid policy...Please read so you have the latest update:

We will now require a 5 day quarantine plan for children enrolled in the kindergarten or After School group only. A child who tests positive will quarantine for 5 days and return with a mask for 5 days. Children younger than 5 will still adhere to our 10 day quarantine policy.

When there is an increase in Covid cases we will require masks to be worn for a few days in the room affected.

If a child is in close contact with someone who has tested positive they will need to remain home and test after the standard incubation period of 5 - 7 days.

If your child is sent home with a fever we will allow them to return if they are fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case by case basis and depending on the severity of symptoms and/or illness.

If your children have traveled out of state and become sick with Covid symptoms we will require testing before returning.
