COVID REMINDERS:

We will now require a 5-day quarantine plan for only children in the kindergarten or After School group. A child who tests positive will quarantine for 5 days and return with a mask for 5 days. Children younger than 5 will still adhere to our 10-day quarantine policy.

SLIGHT CHANGE

If a household member has tested positive, your child must remain home and test after an incubation period of 6-7 days.

If your child has traveled out of state and becomes sick with Covid symptoms we will require testing before returning.

non-Covid illnesses:

If your child is sent home with a fever, we will allow them to return if they are fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case-by-case basis depending on the severity of symptoms and/or illness.

Diarrhea – If your child has three loose stools, we will call you to have your child dismissed. They may return after 24 hours without any loose stools.

Conjunctivitis – If we notice any signs of conjunctivitis, we will call you to dismiss your child. He or she can return once they are on prescribed medication for 24 hours.
