Diarrhea – If your child has three loose stools, we will call you to have your child dismissed. They may return after 24 hours without any loose stools.

COVID REMINDERS:

We will now require a 5-day quarantine plan for only children in the kindergarten or After School group. A child who tests positive will quarantine for 5 days and return with a mask for 5 days. Children younger than 5 will still adhere to our 10-day quarantine policy.

SLIGHT CHANGE

If a household member has tested positive, your child must remain home and test after an incubation period of 6-7 days.

If your child has traveled out of state and becomes sick with Covid symptoms we will require testing before returning.

Non-Covid illnesses:

If your child is sent home with a fever, we will allow them to return if they are fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case-by-case basis

HELP WANTED

HEALTH FORMS ARE REQUIRED TO BE UPDATED YEARLY BY THE STATE. Please ask your pediatrician for an updated form and immunization record at each physical.

All the children need warm coats, hats, and gloves for the days in which we go outside. Winter gear should be in a large bag on their hook and it should stay here.
