VACATION WEEK UPDATE:

We will be closed the week of **July 1**. This week will be used for two in-service days for our staff development and some general maintenance. You have the option of using your free week during that time or paying as usual and using another free week during the year.

COVID UPDATE:

We are happy to inform you that we will adhere to the latest CDC guidelines.

The latest updates suggest we no longer need to isolate for 5 days. Recommendations include staying away from others when you have symptoms and a fever, only to return once you feel better and fever-free.

If your child is sent home with a fever, we will allow them to return if they are fever-free for 24 hours without medication. We will determine if a sibling needs to go home on a case-by-case basis depending on the severity of symptoms and/or illness.

Diarrhea – If your child has three loose stools, we will call you to have your child dismissed. They may return after 24 hours without any loose stools.

Conjunctivitis – If we notice any signs of conjunctivitis, we will call you to dismiss your child. He or she can return once they are on prescribed medication for 24 hours.
